#### IMMIGRATION UPDATE

PERM Labor Certification: Problems and Opportunities;
Limitations on Outsourcing and Independent Contractors: the L-1 Reform Act and New Enforcement Developments;

This program will present a practical approach, based on our experience, toward achieving the greatest success in the most cost-efficient manner under the new PERM regulations. In addition, it will explore the new compliance issues raised in the areas of outsourcing and the use of independent contractors by the L-1 and H-1B Reform Acts and government enforcement in this area.

Under Department of Labor regulations published on March 28, 2005, employers who want to obtain labor certification must navigate the DOL's online PERM system. Planning for PERM filings, and particularly for its more stringent recruitment requirements, and coordinating those requirements with the organization's broader recruitment and hiring cycle, have become critical to winning labor certification. The "mandatory" and the "additional" recruitment steps required for professional positions under the new regulations present both legal/ethical issues and also considerable cost issues. The program will present case studies as examples of what seems to be working under the new regime, and what issues are generating audit letters and denials.

In the broader area of business immigration, the program will update employers on new compliance issues, particularly those raised by the use of independent contractors to perform on-site services of all kinds, from IT consulting to janitorial work. Contractual arrangements for such services must include protections for the employer with regard to immigration compliance by the contractor, as well as the right to verify such compliance. Make sure you know what your organization needs to do, to protect itself in this important area.

Finally, the program will address recent developments in this rapidly changing area of law. For example, the limited number of H-1B visas available under the annual quota, despite the exemptions, continues to present both short- and long-term problems for employers. This is particularly so when considered together with the shortage of permanent visas for India- and China-born professionals, and the potential shortage for all nationalities. The program will clarify these issues and offer some practical solutions.
