In 2008, Mr. Splittgerber received the New York State Association of Criminal Defense Lawyer's Gideon Champion of Justice Award for his efforts as a member of the pro bono defense team that secured the reversal of the wrongful conviction of Martin H. Tankleff.

Earlier in his legal career, Mr. Splittgerber served as an Assistant District Attorney in the Office of the Kings County District Attorney in Brooklyn, New York. As a Senior Appellate Attorney in that office, he successfully briefed and argued

numerous cases in the state and federal courts of New York, including the New York Court of Appeals and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit.

After graduating from law school, Mr. Splittgerber served as a Law Clerk to the Honorable Betsy Barros of the Supreme Court of New York, Kings County. While at law school, Mr. Splittgerber served as the Senior Managing Editor of the *Wisconsin International Law Journal*. He also served as an intern to the Honorable Sarah O'Brien of the Dane County Circuit Court; in the Madison City Attorney's Office, where he focused on land use, zoning, and environmental law; and received a significant grant to practice immigration and asylum law in San Francisco.
