During law school, Ms. Quattrone was a Note Editor of the Boston University School of Law *Journal of Science and Technology Law*, served as a Student Attorney with the Boston University Immigrants' Rights Clinic, and was a judicial intern for the Honorable Kathe Tuttmann at the Middlesex Superior Court in Woburn, Massachusetts. As an undergraduate, Ms. Quattrone served as a congressional intern at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office on Disability in Washington, DC.

Before attending law school, Ms. Quattrone worked for a health care consulting company to assist privately held physician practices increase their revenue through monitoring daily office operations, medical billing, proper use of electronic health records, and helping to ensure compliance with federal and state regulations. She also worked in fundraising for the United Way, where she helped raise significant funds for nonprofit organizations throughout Camden, New Jersey. While there, she was appointed to the Advisory Board for the New Jersey Partnership for Healthy Kids, a partnership with the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, which worked to reverse the obesity epidemic across the state of New Jersey.
